Getting Started Here are a few key features and types of AutoCAD workflows. CAD Views and Other Components Each drawing in AutoCAD has a view (also called frame). A default view, called 2D Drafting (2D), is set by default when you launch AutoCAD. From any open 2D drawing, you can open an additional drawing view to design a specific type of object. You can move to any drawing in any view by using one of these shortcuts: Ctrl + Click (also known as "Double-Click") Selects the nearest drawing by default (within an X,Y distance) (also known as "Double-Click") Selects the nearest drawing by default (within an X,Y distance) Shift + Double-Click or Spacebar + Double-Click Resizes the window to a new dimension, with no change to the drawing or + Double-Click or Spacebar + Double-Click Resizes the window to a new dimension, with no change to the drawing Alt + Double-Click or Shift + Spacebar + Double-Click Moves to a drawing in a different view Note that some shortcuts might not

In addition, some of these products are available for free on the Android Marketplace. In 2013, AutoCAD was also integrated with Autodesk design Review (DR) and salesforce.com. AutoCAD can be viewed using the app "AutoCAD" on Android or iOS devices. AutoCAD plugin architecture AutoCAD provides a plugin framework that makes it possible to create custom extensions or add-ons to the base application. AutoCAD's plugin architecture is similar to that of Apple's Mac OS X. In this approach, plugins are written in a programming language that is based on an architecture similar to AutoLISP. The design and implementation of AutoCAD plugins follow a formal programming structure that is similar to AutoLISP and similar to VBA macros for Microsoft Office applications. This allows for designing plugins as a series of simple programming steps, instead of having to write a complex macro or programming code. Plugins are typically organized in packages called scripts or macros, with each script containing a single set of commands or functions. The basic design of these scripts follows a certain standard, but not all extensions are compatible. History AutoCAD's origins go back to 1975 and the first CAD system called AutoLISP, which was licensed to Wang Laboratories and sold in 1977. AutoLISP was a completely different programming language than any other CAD systems had at the time. In addition to a solid object model, AutoLISP featured the following characteristics: Well-defined interfaces, allowing direct access to the functionality of the system Numerical results Support for a variety of input devices: mouse, keyboard, tablet, scanner Easy storage and retrieval of files Support for file input and output, text, line, and polygon objects In 1978, Autodesk began to sell a self-contained version of AutoLISP called AutoLISP -B. In 1979, Autodesk released the first version of AutoCAD, which was based on AutoLISP and designed to work with AutoLISP.
